Grammar lesson: The Formation of Nouns and Adjectives

How do we form nouns and adjectives in the English language?

- ➤ Through adding suffixes.
- Suffix: is a morpheme (a small dependent unit of meaning) placed at the end of a word.
- ❖ The suffixes are used to form nouns, adjectives, and adverbs.

| Nouns (Root+ Suffix) | Adjectives (Root+ Suffix) |
|--|---|
| Ion, tion, ment, ence, ance, ness, ing, ity, ty. | Ic, ical, al, ive, ed, able/ible, ing, ous, ious, ent, less, ful. |

<u>I-How to use suffixes to create nouns from adjectives and verbs:</u>

Tip 1: Add **–ment** to form nouns from adjectives or verbs:

| Verbs | Nouns |
|--------------|---------------|
| To invest | Investment |
| To appoint | Appointment |
| To develop | Development |
| To establish | Establishment |

Tip 2: Add **–tion** or **–sion** to form nouns from verbs:

| Verbs | Nouns |
|---------------|--------------|
| To evolve | Evolution |
| To contribute | Contribution |
| To adjudicate | Adjudication |
| To dispute | Disputation |

Tip 3: Add **–ance** or **–ence** to form nouns from adjectives or verbs: The suffix **–ance** (or – ence) can be added to either adjectives or verbs to form nouns.

This is particularly used for adjectives ending in **–ent** or **–ant** (where the spelling changes to replace t with **-ce**)

| Adjectives | Nouns |
|-------------|--------------|
| Independent | Independence |
| Silent | Silence |
| Resist | Resistance |

II- Tips to formulate Adjectives:

Tip 1: In most cases, we can form adjectives through adding "ed" to the stem when the verb is regular.

| Verbs | Adjectives |
|--------------|-------------|
| To appoint | Appointed |
| To draft | Drafted |
| To establish | Established |

Tip 2: However, we can form adjectives from the past participle of the verb if it is irregular.

| Verb | Adjective |
|----------|-----------|
| To write | Written |
| To break | Broken |

Tip 3: In most cases, if you have a **noun that ends** with the following **suffixes (ty, ity, and ness) remove/drop them to get the adjective.**

| Noun | Adjective |
|-----------------|-----------|
| Sadness | Sad |
| Morality | Moral |
| Hones ty | Honest |

Adjectives of IVE

| Verbs | Adjectives |
|---------------|--------------|
| To cooperate | Cooperative |
| To adjudicate | Adjudicative |
| To invest | Investive |

Adjectives of Able

| Verbs | Adjectives |
|-----------|---------------|
| To ratify | Ratifiable |
| Indemnify | Indemnifiable |

| To prevent | Preventable |
|------------|---------------|
| To adopt | Adoptable |
| To object | Objectionable |

Adjectives of ious

| Verb | Adjectives |
|------------|--------------|
| To dispute | Disputatious |
| To fail | Faillious |

III- Tips for formulating Verbs

In most cases, if you have a noun that ends with the following **suffixes (ance, ence) drop/remove them to get the verb.**

| Nouns | Verbs |
|------------|-----------|
| Avoidance | To Avoid |
| Existence | To exist |
| Appearance | To appear |
