Justices of the U.S. Supreme Court and circuit and district judges are appointed by the

President of the United States if approved by a majority vote of the U.S. Senate. These

justices and judges serve "during good behavior"— in effect, a life term. Presidents usually

nominate persons to be judges who are members of their own political party. Persons

appointed are usually distinguished lawyers, law professors, or lower federal court or state

court judges.

Once these judges are appointed their salaries cannot be reduced. Federal judges may only be

removed from office through an impeachment process in which charges are made by the

House of Representatives and a trial is conducted by the Senate. In the entire history of the

United States, only a few judges have been impeached and those removed were found to have

committed <u>serious misconduct</u>. These protections allow federal judges to exercise

independent judgment without political or outside interference or influence.

In both the federal and state systems, judicial candidates are almost always lawyers with many

years of experience. There is no specific course of training for judges and no examination.

Some states require judges to attend continuing education programs to learn about

developments in the law. Both the federal and state court systems offer beginning and

continuing education programs for judges.
