Objective

Practice different text formats and list types in LaTeX.

Tasks

1. Format a short paragraph with various font sizes and types

Write a paragraph, and use LaTeX commands to format the text:

- Bold text: `\textbf{Bold Text}`
- Italics: `\textit{Italic Text}`
- Underline: `\underline{Underlined Text}`
- Different font sizes: Try `\tiny`, `\small`, `\Large`, etc.

2. Create Lists

Practice creating various types of lists:

- Numbered list: Use the `enumerate` environment.
- Bulleted list: Use the `itemize` environment.
- Nested lists: Experiment with combining lists inside each other.
